Day begins...

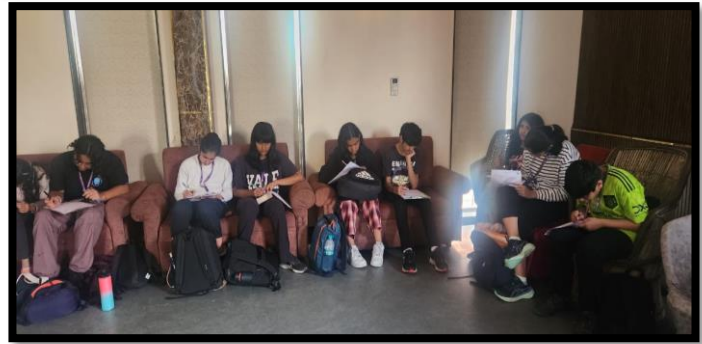
